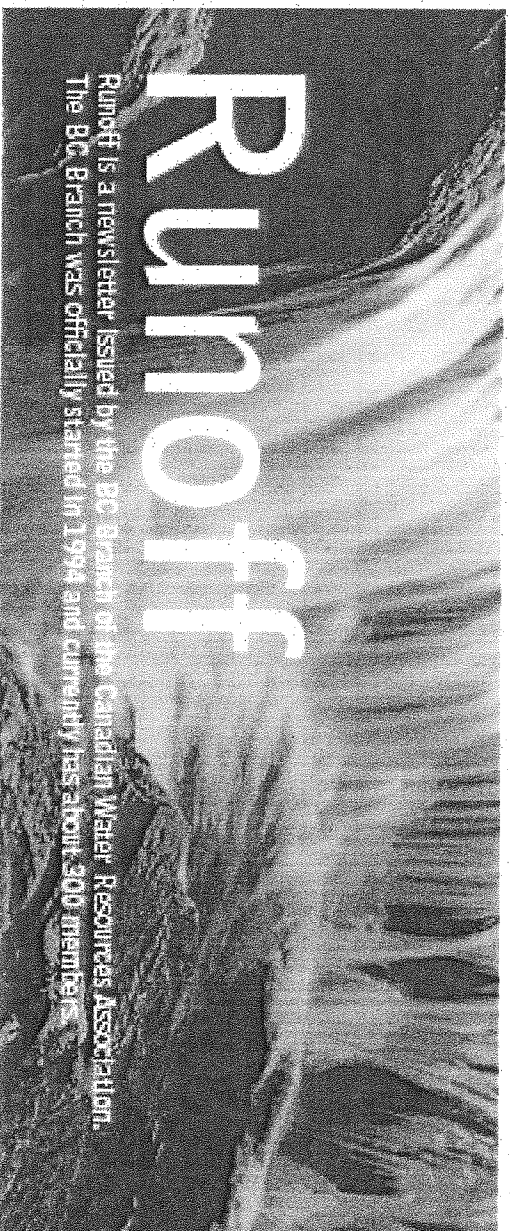

[A Blueprint for Watershed Governance in British Columbia](#) New report from the POLIS Project on Ecological Governance

The new policy report [A Blueprint for Watershed Governance in British Columbia](#) was published by the POLIS Project on Ecological Governance at the University of Victoria in January 2014. It focuses on current water governance issues in B.C. and offers a path forward for how the Province could transform its approaches to decision-making to ensure a more sustainable and resilient future.

The Blueprint proposes that water-management decision-making be aligned with the ecological boundaries of watersheds, instead of political lines on a map, as the best way to achieve positive, long-term ecological, social, and economic outcomes. It outlines nine winning conditions to ensure success and offers a strategic 10-year plan to really make B.C.'s newly passed Water Sustainability Act work.
