

Hullcar expert named

An independent expert has been commissioned to support the review of Spallumcheen's Hullcar aquifer.

Oliver Brandes, the co-director of the POLIS Project on Ecological Governance at the University of Victoria's Centre for Global Studies, will provide advice and oversee aspects of the review.

Brandes will also lead a team that will make recommendations to Environment Minister George Heyman about best practices for the agricultural sector providing clean drinking water.
